

Treasure Chest Rules

- 1. The Rotary Club of Ayr will make one award of up to £250 every month to help small, local groups or individuals.
- 2. The preferred target beneficiaries are clubs and organisations working with children, teenagers, the elderly, vulnerable people and the disabled. Applications may also be made by individuals.
- 3. Applicants should be from Ayr or its immediate vicinity.
- 4. Please apply on the form on the Rotary Club of Ayr's website and submitted online, or printed off and posted to the Club Secretary. He will acknowledge receipt.
- 5. All applications will be vetted by two members of the Rotary Club and then included in a file for consideration.
- 6. Each month authorised members of Ayr Rotary Club will review the file of applications and decide who should be the beneficiary that month.
- 7. The Club Council will ratify the decision and announced to the successful applicant, then on the website and in the press.
- 8. Successful applicants, will be included in future Rotary publicity.
- 9. As Rotary is a non-political and non-religious organisation, applications which directly promote any political or religious activity cannot be considered.
- 10. Priority will be given to small groups and individuals who do not receive support from paid staff and/or professional fundraisers.
- 11. Applicants do not need to be a registered charity but the Rotary Club of Ayr will reserve the right to verify the authenticity of an the application
